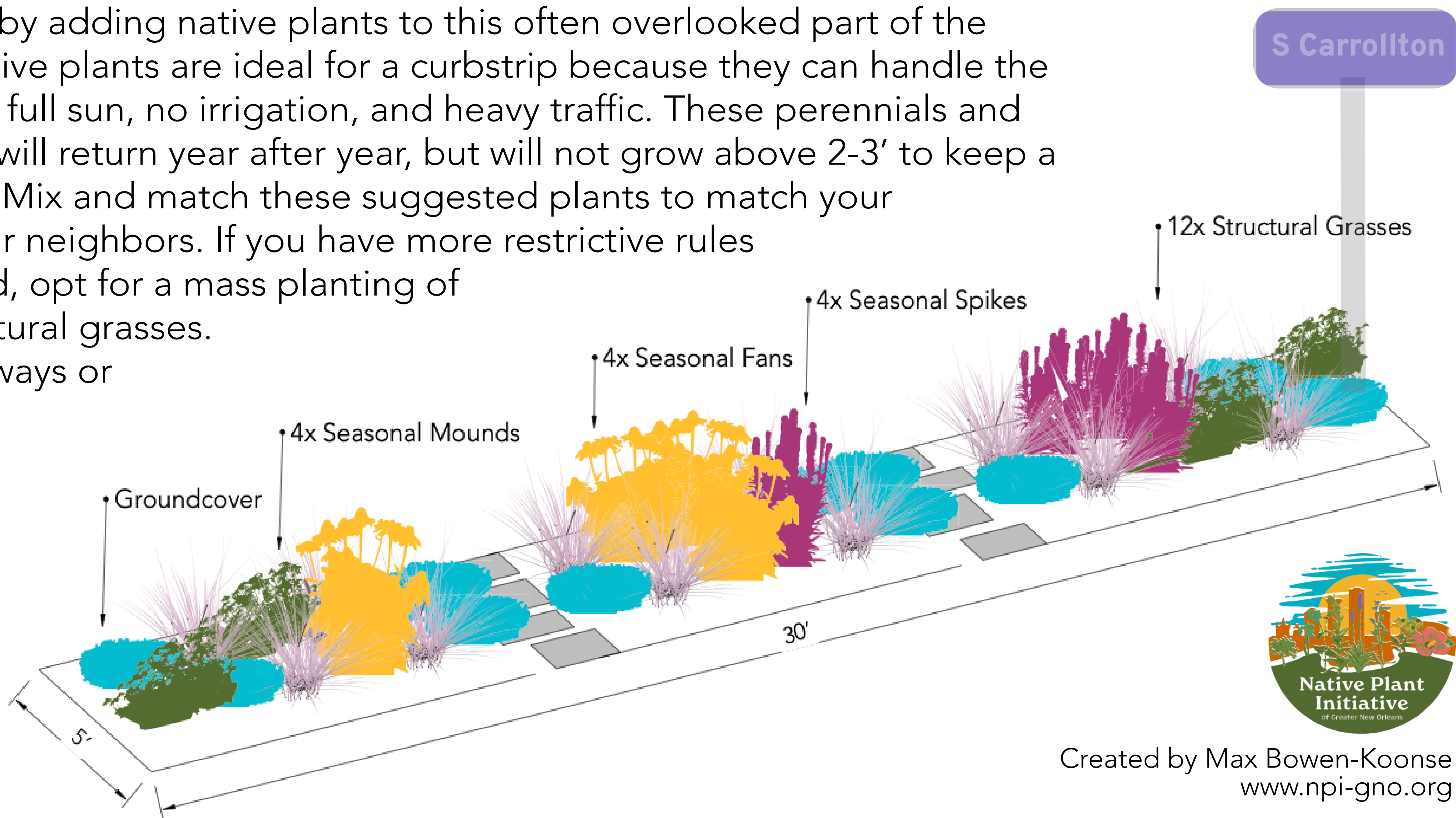


Carrollton Curbstrip

Up your curb-appeal by adding native plants to this often overlooked part of the home landscape. Native plants are ideal for a curbstrip because they can handle the harsh environment of full sun, no irrigation, and heavy traffic. These perennials and self-seeding annuals will return year after year, but will not grow above 2-3' to keep a safe site line for cars. Mix and match these suggested plants to match your vision and please your neighbors. If you have more restrictive rules in your neighborhood, opt for a mass planting of groundcover or structural grasses. The addition of pathways or borders keeps the garden looking manicured even when not in bloom.

Muhlenbergia capillaris, Gulf Coast Muhly
Muhlenbergia reverchonii, Seep Muhly
Eragrostis spectabilis, Purple Lovegrass
Eragrostis elliottii, Elliott's Lovegrass
Carex leavenworthii, Lawn Sedge
Bouteloua curtipendula, Sideoats Grama

4x Seasonal Mounds

Rudbeckia hirta, Black-Eyed Susan
Monarda punctata, Spotted Beebalm
Pycnanthemum tenuifolium, Narrowleaf Mountainmint
Gaillardia pulchella, Indian Blanket (annual)
Gaillardia aestivalis, Lanceleaf Blanketflower
Conoclinium coelestinum, Blue Mistflower
Phlox pilosa, Downy Phlox
Clinopodium carolinianum, Georgia Calamint

12x Groundcover

Helenium amarum, Yellow Sneezeweed (annual)
Mimosa strigilosa, Pink Powderpuff
Symphotrichum ericoides, Heath Aster
Callirhoe involucrata, Purple Poppy Mallow
Oenothera speciosa, Pink Evening Primrose
Callirhoe papaver, Wood Wine Cup
Salvia lyrata, Lyre-leaved Sage

4x Seasonal Spikes

Liatris species, Blazing Stars
Oenothera lindheimeri, Beeblossom
Ratibida columnifera, Long-Headed Coneflower
Ratibida pinnata, Gray -Headed Coneflower
Salvia farinacea, Mealeycup Sage
Monarda citriodora, Lemon Bee Balm (annual)

4x Seasonal Fans

Echinacea purpurea, Purple Coneflower
Echinacea pallida, Pale Purple Coneflower
Salvia coccinea, Scarlet Sage (annual)
Coreopsis tinctoria, Painted Tickseed (annual)
Helenium flexuosm, Purple-Headed Sneezeweed
Coreopsis lanceolata, Lanceleaf Coreopsis
Symphotrichum lateriflorum, Calico Aster
