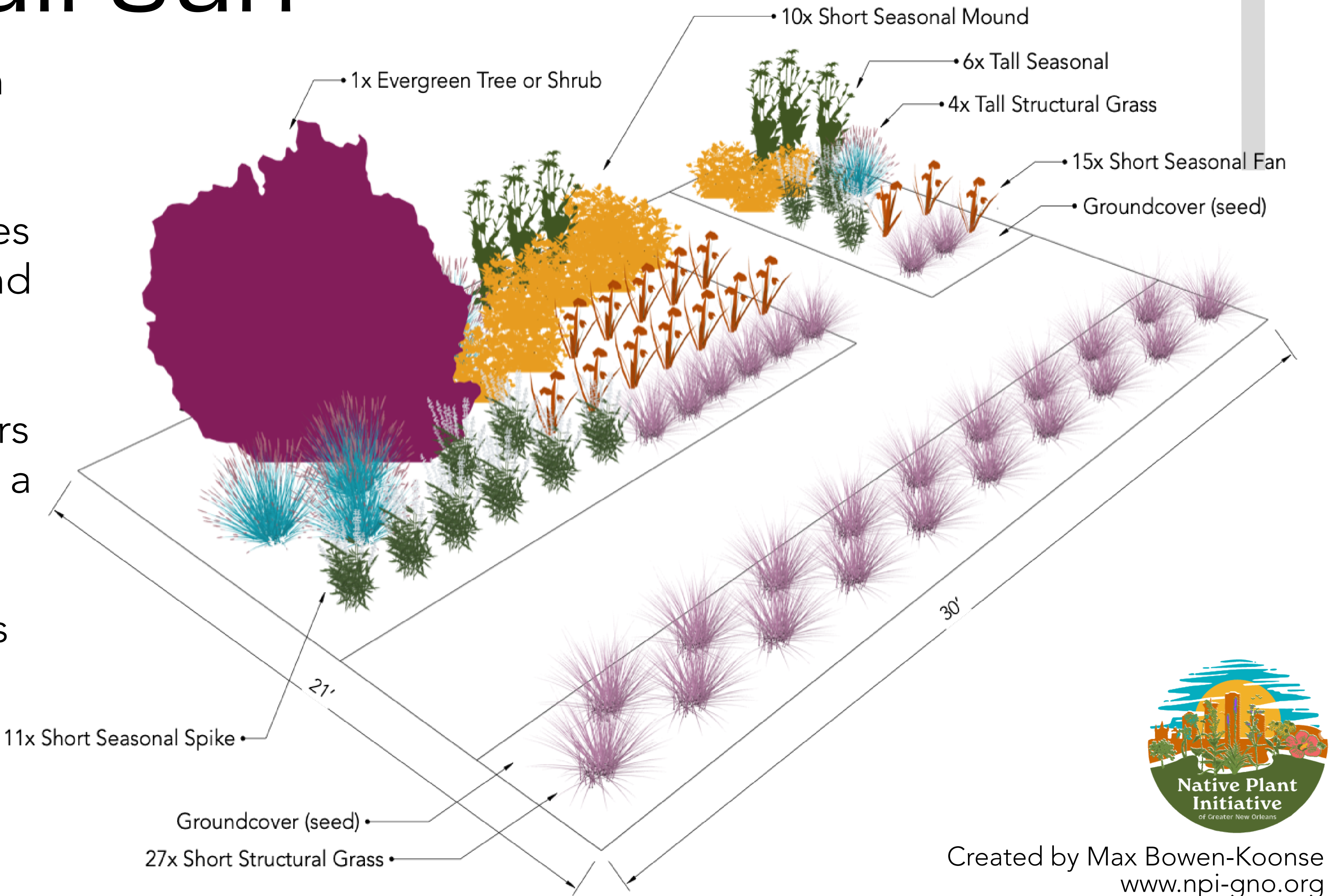


Freret Full Sun

Here is a combination of seasonal bloomers for color and a combination of grasses for structure above and below ground. These plants will thrive in yards that get 6+ hours of full sun. Seeding in a fast-growing groundcover will help outcompete weeds as your garden gets established.
